

Holmesglen Access Scholarship 2024

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

The Access Scholarship is available for government funded Holmesglen courses.

Applicants cannot be a recipient of any other scholarship/award, or be eligible for VET Student Loans VET student loans, fee HELP or other government schemes including jobtrainer or free TAFE.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Scholarship value will be credited to tuition fees.
- Applicants will not receive any monetary payment to the value of the scholarship unless fees have already been paid, in which case the student may receive a cheque.
- The scholarship amount awarded will only be applied to the course that is named in the scholarship application and cannot be used towards another course should you chose to change courses.
- An applicant may only be awarded one scholarship during their study at Holmesglen.
- All correspondence will be via email, including acknowledgement of receipt of applications. Please ensure you put your correct email address on the application form so that this communication can occur.
- Scholarships may take up to 4 weeks to process. Please do not contact Student Wellbeing regarding the progress of your application unless an issue arises.
- If tuition fees are reduced in any event, scholarship value will be adjusted accordingly ie. application of concession, study load reduction etc.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The Access Scholarship is available to VET students (Certificate, Diploma, Advanced Diploma) who because of financial hardship, might not otherwise enjoy the benefits of participation in tertiary education.
- Scholarships are not available to those on VET Student Loans.
- Applications for the 2024 Holmesglen Access Scholarship open on the 12 of February, 2024 and close at the end of November, 2024.
- The scholarship committee meets monthly to assess applications and funds are subject to availability.
- Prospective or current Holmesglen students are eligible to apply.
- Only Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia can apply.
- International students studying in Australia are not eligible, refer to the International Centre for International Student Scholarships.

- The Access Scholarship is available for government funded Holmesglen courses.
- Applicants who are a family member of a Holmesglen employee or agent are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants cannot be a recipient of any other scholarship/award or be eligible for VET student loans, fee HELP or other government schemes including jobtrainer or free TAFE.
- Documentary evidence required to support application including: financial information (bank statement, income statement), statement of fees (You can get this from the info desk on campus and referee letter).

SELECTION PROCESS

1. Applicants are required to complete the Scholarship Application Form and attach their additional supporting documents.
2. Applicants must complete an appointment with a counsellor or welfare officer at Student Wellbeing.
3. Submit application and documentation to Student Wellbeing, (Chadstone, Glen Waverley, Moorabbin) City Campus Information Office or by email to **studentwellbeing@holmesglen.edu.au**.
4. The Access Scholarship Review Panel will assess all applications in consultation with the student's faculty and relevant staff members.
5. Successful applicants will be notified in writing via email.
6. The decision of the Access Scholarship review panel is final and no further communication will be entered into.
