

Holmesglen/Monash Health Allied Health Assistance Scholarship SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Scholarship value will be credited to course expenses such as approved texts, materials and uniform costs.
- Applicants will not receive any monetary payment to the value of the scholarship.
- Scholarship award is non-transferable.
- An applicant may only be awarded one scholarship during their study at Holmesglen.
- All correspondence will be via email, including acknowledgement of receipt of applications.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The Holmesglen/Monash Health Scholarship is available to current Monash Health volunteers with permanent refugee status and eligible to study and receive a Government Supported Place (GSP).
- International students or Temporary Visa holders are not eligible, please refer to the International Centre for International Student Scholarships.
- This Scholarship will be available twice a year, approximately two months prior to the Program commencement date in February or July.
- Applicants must have the ability to transport self to and from the Holmesglen campus.
- Applicants are required to demonstrate basic computer and internet search skills.
- Applicants must have the physical capacity to undertake work place assessments relevant to the role
- Applicants are required to have functional English language skills (i.e. capable of undertaking study at the required level in line with the Australian Qualification Framework
- Applicants who are a family member of a Holmesglen employee or agent are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants cannot be a recipient of any other scholarship/award or be eligible for VET Student Loans.
- Documentary evidence is required to support your application.

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SELECTION PROCESS

1. Applicants are required to complete the Scholarship Application Form and attach their additional supporting documents including a completed VEVO check for applicants for visa holders <https://online.immi.gov.au/evo/firstParty>.
2. Submit application and documentation to Holmesglen at healthsciences@holmesglen.edu.au
3. Review Panel will assess all applications
4. Suitable applicants will be invited to attend an interview at Holmesglen's Moorabbin campus or via Videoconference.
5. Successful applicants will be notified in writing via email.
6. The decision of the Holmesglen/Monash Health Scholarship review panel is final and no further communication will be entered into.
7. Ready to commence full-time study for 12 months course duration. Practical Placement will occur after the
